This extraordinary piece of furniture has been crafted from reclaimed barrique barrels that were once used for aging fine wines over many years. Made in the Palatinate region of Germany, each tabletop tells its own unique story – shaped by wine, time, and traditional craftsmanship. No two pieces are alike; every tabletop is a true one-of-a-kind creation.

Material:

- **Wood:** Oak wood from recycled barrique barrels
- **Origin:** Barrique barrels from renowned wine regions, refurbished and processed in Alsenz (Rhineland-Palatinate), Germany.

Special Features:

- **Unique Appearance:** The grain, texture, and coloration of the wood reflect the influence of the wine and the natural aging process inside the barrel. Depending on whether the tabletop is crafted from the inner staves, the outer barrel surface, or the original barrel head, each piece displays its own distinctive character. Variations in color, small cracks, or natural irregularities are inherent qualities of solid wood and highlight the authenticity of every VINLIGNA product.
- **Sustainability:** By repurposing retired barrique barrels, premium oak wood is thoughtfully reused and given a second life. Your tabletop beautifully combines sustainability with timeless aesthetics.

Instructions for Use and Care:

1. **Before first use:** Wipe the surface with a soft, slightly damp cloth and allow it to dry thoroughly.
2. **Cleaning:** Remove dirt with a damp cloth. Please avoid harsh cleaners, abrasive products, or excessively wet cloths. Standing moisture should be avoided.
3. **Everyday Protection:** Use coasters for glasses, bottles, and hot items. Do not place hot pots or pans directly on the surface, as extreme heat may damage the wood. Always use proper cutting boards for food preparation.
4. **Drying:** After cleaning, wipe the surface dry. Ensure good ventilation and avoid consistently high humidity levels.
5. **Care:** Depending on use, we recommend treating the tabletop approximately every three months with a suitable wood care oil. Apply a thin layer, allow it to absorb, and remove any excess oil. This will protect the wood and preserve its natural beauty.
